Terms and Conditions

Ticket:

- 1. It is compulsory to have purchased a ticket in order to take part in the event.
- 2. Tickets must be purchased through our registration form or for specific reasons through a member of the ROCOR Youth Committee.
- 3. Tickets are non-refundable.
- 4. All information provided by you on the registration form must be true and accurate.
- 5. It is your responsibility to ascertain whether the Event has been cancelled or re-scheduled. If the event is cancelled or re-scheduled, the Orgaisers will use reasonable endeavours to notify you using the details provided on the form - most commonly this will be by email.

Food and Drink:

- 1. You are responsible for letting us know if you have any allergies.
- 2. The consumption of food is made at your own risk.
- 3. You must not bring any alcoholic drink with you to the ball.
- 4. To get a drink from the bar you must present a ticket (2 will be given to you at the entry).

At the Event:

- 1. The Event Organisers shall not be liable for any loss or damage attendance at the event including any disappointment or loss or damage to any personal property you bring to the venue (we advise you not to bring anything of value to the event).
- 2. Whilst the Event Organisers will make every effort to resolve any unforeseen difficulties that may arise during the event, the Event Promoter's security agent reserves the right to refuse admission or exclude any member of the public who becomes abusive or who behaves inappropriately or in any other reasonable circumstance. In this circumstance, no refund will be given.
- 3. WARNINGS Prolonged exposure to loud music or noise may cause damage to your hearing. Special effects, which may include without limitation, sound, audio-visual, pyrotechnic effects or lighting effects may be featured at the Event, which may not be suitable for those with photosensitive epilepsy, or similar conditions.
